

CLUBS | TRAINING | MEETINGS

OHHS Color Guard auditions are not like traditional auditions. They offer team positions to any student that shows zeal and commitment to learning all aspects of the program (dance, act, spin) along with committing to their daily rehearsals and their performance schedule.

This last fall season, the Color Guard “made waves” as they came in second place under their own Color Guard category at competition. Just 0.6 points away from their name being called for the High Color Guard award in the preliminary round. In finals, they were .4 away from 1st. They are eager to have new students join in the fun as part of the Wildcat Show Band.




JAZZ BAND AUDITIONS– DUE MAY 10
